Recordall® Brand Disc Series water meters with a mechanical analog display are commonly used water meters in many municipal agencies and water districts. Recordall meters are positive displacement meters with nutating disc technology. The internal mechanism and analog display are connected through a watertight seal.

These unit function mechanically; there are no electronics or telemetry in these units. It is therefore impervious to interference from electronic or radio/telemetry equipment in close proximity.

Field experience and lab testing have shown that the mechanical function of Badger Meter Recordall 25 Water Meter is not affected (accuracy and repeatability) by the use of WaterSignal LLC Generation 4 (WaterCompass) in close proximity. Due the similarity of design, the same is true for other Recordall Brand Disc Series water meters, including, but not limited to, the following models;
